PHARMACY AND POISONS ORDINANCE (Chapter 138)

DIRECTION MADE BY THE DISCIPLINARY COMMITTEE OF THE PHARMACY AND POISONS BOARD OF HONG KONG

It is hereby notified that a Disciplinary Committee appointed by the Pharmacy and Poisons Board of Hong Kong under section 15 of the Pharmacy and Poisons Ordinance (Chapter 138, Laws of Hong Kong) to inquire into the conduct of an authorized seller of poisons, namely Yan Woo Pharmacy O/B Perfect Leader Corporation Limited, at Shop B, G/F, Hung On Building, 2–4A King's Road, Tin Hau, Hong Kong has conducted an inquiry on 18 July 2024 in accordance with section 16 of the Pharmacy and Poisons Ordinance.

The said Committee was satisfied after the inquiry that Yan Woo Pharmacy O/B Perfect Leader Corporation Limited had been guilty of misconduct in that at the material time, Yan Woo Pharmacy O/B Perfect Leader Corporation Limited was convicted of the following offences under the Pharmacy and Poisons Regulations (Chapter 138A, Laws of Hong Kong) made under the Pharmacy and Poisons Ordinance on the date specified below at Eastern Magistrates' Courts for which the following order was imposed:—

In addition, the said Committee was satisfied that Yan Woo Pharmacy O/B Perfect Leader Corporation Limited had failed to comply with sections 1.4a, 1.4b, 2e, 2f, 3.3a, 3.3b, 3.3d, 3.4f and 3.4j of the Code of Practice for Authorized Seller of Poisons (2021 version).

It is further notified that under section 16(2)(b) of the Pharmacy and Poisons Ordinance, the said Committee directed that Yan Woo Pharmacy O/B Perfect Leader Corporation Limited be disqualified from being an authorized seller of poisons for a period of 7 days with effect from 30 August 2024. The said Committee added that its direction should be published in the Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region Gazette with an account of the proceedings.
